Academics

The educational program of St. Cecilia School meets the requirements set by the Diocese of Covington and the Kentucky Department of Education. St. Cecilia School is accredited by the Kentucky Non-Public School Commission. The Diocese of Covington sets our academic standards. The students receive a solid program of academic subjects that include: Reading, Spelling, Vocabulary, Phonics, Grammar, Writing, Literature, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Art, Music, Physical Education, Spanish, Computer, and Library

Safe Environment for our Children: In compliance with Diocesan policy St. Cecilia School offers a safe environment program at least biannually to its students. "All parishes and schools in the Diocese shall offer for parents and students, on at least a biennial basis, a "safe environment for children" component of the educational program, in keeping with the American Bishops' "Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People."

Special Needs/Gifted Education: Provisions are made for individual needs that include additional instruction and modifications for learning disabilities. Opportunities to excel beyond grade level instruction are available also.

Religious Training: All students receive religious and moral training as one of their core subjects. The religion classes follow the curriculum guidelines established by the Diocese of Covington and are under the jurisdiction of the Pastor. Students and teachers attend Mass twice each week. The sacraments of Reconciliation and First Communion are celebrated in the second grade. Students prepare for and receive the sacrament of Confirmation in the eighth grade. Daily prayer and rosary are an intrinsic part of each day. Opportunities for service and stewardship, modeled after the lives of the Saints, put faith into action and are a part of the school mission.

Reading Program K - 2: Our school has adopted the Super Kid Reading Program for grades kindergarten - 2nd.

Algebra: Algebra is offered for qualifying students in the 8th grade.

Spanish: 1st grade - 8th grade have weekly Spanish lessons.

Media Center: Our school offers an up to date Media Center where students are able to access the Internet for research, check out a variety of DVD's on the lives of the saints and other holy people, check out numerous books on many topics including saints and holy people, historical figures, classical literature and more.
