There will be some players from FC Cincinnati come one night for the camp. We had a sub-committee meet last week to renew the bylaws. Our ticket sales for the Stag have been slow...between 25 or 30. Not having the online registration has hindered our sales. We need to sell to 50 people to be successful. We are going to consider the online sign-ups through Signup Genius.
