Where&When:

On Saturday, November 9th, participants should arrive at St. Cecilia School beginning at 8:00am. You will be greeted by the Welcome team and we will help you settle in with your packed bags.

We will discuss the weekend schedule when you arrive. This is an overnight retreat. Participants are expected to stay for the duration of the weekend to truly experience all that God has planned for you!

To ensure peace of mind and a focus on the weekend, be sure to inform family and make arrangements at home. If you have a special circumstance regarding attendance, please share it with the retreat leaders so we can help you get the most out of Welcome.

The Welcome weekend will conclude on Sunday afternoon around 3:00pm.

What Should I Bring?

1. Comfortable clothing and extra clothes as needed for two days of gathering and one overnight.
2. Extra layers to ensure comfort in warm or cool rooms.
3. All toiletry items necessary for an overnight stay. Please note that there are no shower facilities available. All guests will have access to sinks/restrooms.
4. Pillows and blankets to ensure comfortable sleeping arrangements. Guests who have air mattresses or cots are asked to bring them too. They will be provided for those who do not have their own.
5. Though we hope to "disconnect" during our stay, phone/chargers as needed.
6. You are welcome to bring any journals, devotionals, or your Bible but it's not necessary.
7. We will attend mass as a group on Sunday.
8. All food, drinks and snacks will be provided during your stay.
